

Directions from East Ontario: Take ON-401 W toward Toronto. Then keep left at the fork to continue onto Ontario 401 Express. Continue on the 401 Express until exit 27 for Highway 7, toward Richmond Hill/Markham/ON-7. Follow Highway 7/York Regional Rd 7 to Warden Ave/ York Regional Rd 5. Once on Warden Ave, the hotel will be on your right.
